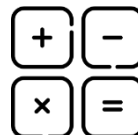


# Curriculum Overview

## Writing

**Outcome:** To write independent sentences

We will be practising and building on the following skills:

- Writing dictated sentences
- Naming letters (A,B,C etc)
- Revise and practice our Year 1 work

Before writing our own sentences, we will learn to:

- Use question marks and exclamation marks
- Use 'and', 'but' and 'or'
- Add 'er', 'est' and 'un'
- Add -s, -es, -ing, -ed

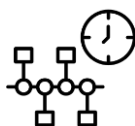
