Dear Parents/Guardians,

As you are aware, Y2 children will be taking part in SATs this May. The national tests will take place in the mornings of week beginning 16<sup>th</sup> May 2022. At this time of year we usually hold a parents meeting, however this year we will be posting a virtual SATs information guide on our website, after half term and will send the link via class dojo and the school messaging service. This will give all the details of the days for each test, how long they last for, the number of tests for each subject and what type of questions to expect. The children are all working hard and making excellent progress towards their targets in class and we have completed many practice tests to get them familiar with the process (for example, the weekly Maths arithmetic homework is directly linked to the types of questions they will face in the Maths Paper 1).

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support and suggest that the best ways of supporting learning from home are: keeping a structured routine (sleep, meal times, quiet place to study) keeping up with the daily reading, completing the weekly homework and attending any booster sessions that are offered. We also have the online websites to make use of; TT rockstars, Spelling Shed & Purple Mash

If you would like to complete some extra revision, then the school will be creating some revision packs for after half term. Also the government site below has past example SATs that will give you a good indication of the type of questions that your child will be expected to complete.
