## Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June – Y1 –Y6 Sports Day

On **Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June** we will be holding our annual Sports Day for Y1 to Y6 (Early Years dates will be announced separately).

Sports Day will start, for KS1 (Y1 and 2) children at **9:05am** and last approximately 1 hour. The children will rotate round a number of different sports related stations performing as a team. We hope to include running, throwing, jumping with stations that require an element of skill such as hitting a target. Parents are welcome to stay and support their children.

KS2 (Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6) children will start at **10:15am** and the children will rotate around several activities demonstrating skill, speed, agility and teamwork; again parents are welcome to come and support their children. This should take just over an hour. Parents are also welcome to take photographs of their own children, however members of staff will challenge people taking general pictures of the day.

All children are to come to school in uniform as normal and bring their PE kit with them. Children in KS2 will represent their house teams and will be encouraged to wear a t-shirt that represents that colour (Newton-Red, Curie-Yellow, Hawking-Green or Johnson-Blue).

Over the last few years, children and parents have thoroughly enjoyed Sports Day and I am sure this year will be no exception. Furthermore, please give consideration to the weather conditions it has been extremely hot recently so please send them with a drink, a sun hat and sun cream. Next week there is some rain forecast so hopefully it will be a little cooler. The most important part of the day is your child's safety therefore if the field is wet then I will postpone the event (parents will be notified by the school text system) and we will rearrange a new date. Furthermore, the school gates will be open on this day to allow parents to come and go, so extra staff will be outside to ensure the site is safe.
